



Addendum

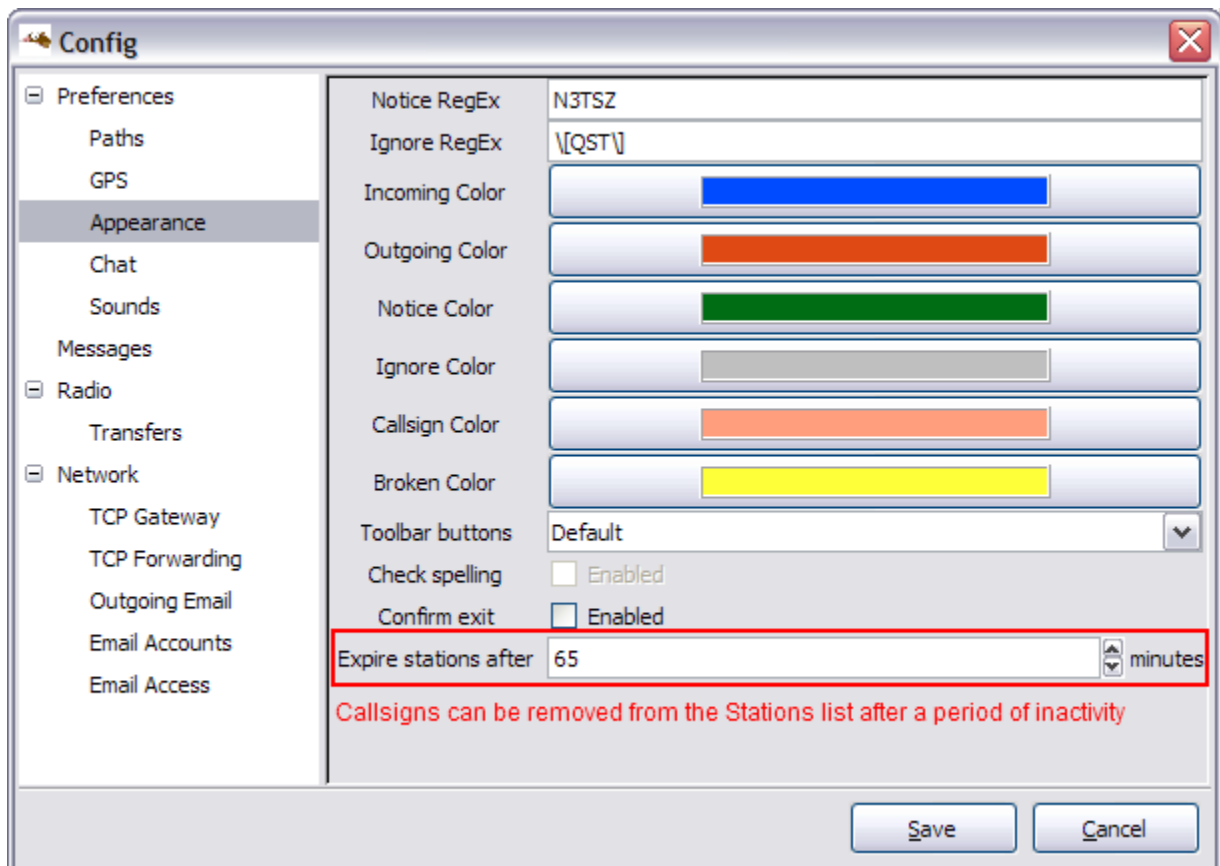
This addendum is an update to the D-RATS Operating Guide and includes changes since version 0.3.3 through Daily Build 02232012.

Note: Any version number containing a “b”, such as 0.3.3b6 is older than 0.3.3. It is recommended that you move up to Daily Build 02232012, as it is the latest release. You can find the Daily Builds for Linux, MAC and Windows at: http://dev.d-rats.com/drats_daily/daily-02232012/.

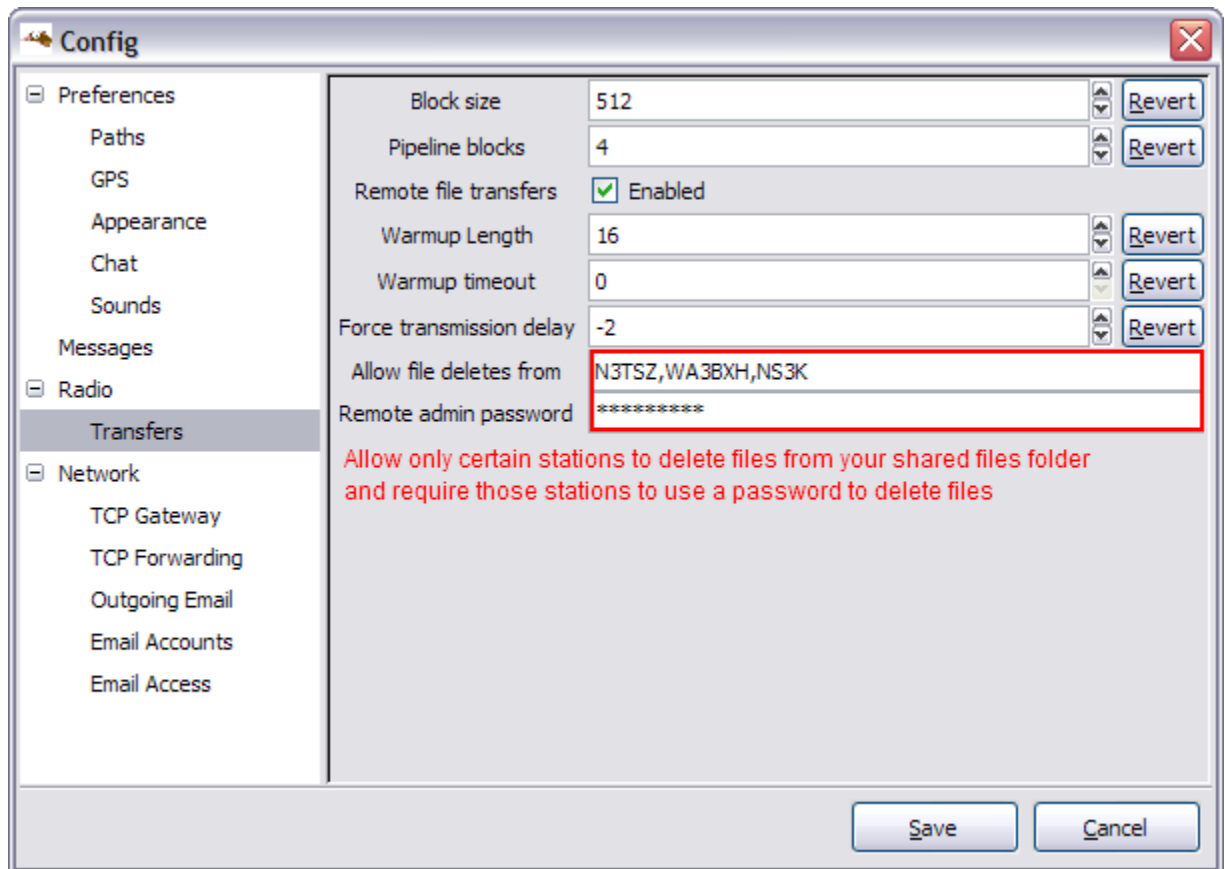
This latest version contains bug fixes mostly pertaining to GPS parsing, and a few enhancements. The sign-off message is now sent correctly.

The Windows version now has an uninstaller and D-RATS appears in the Add/Remove programs list.

Click on File>Preferences, or press CTRL+P to open the Config window. Under Appearance, there is a new feature which helps you keep the Stations list to a manageable size. Expire stations after lets you remove inactive callsigns from the Stations list after “n” minutes. Zero disables this function.



The latest Daily Build allows remote file deletion by those stations named in the Allow file deletes from box. Under Transfers, enter callsigns in the Allow file deletes from box, separated by commas, which are allowed to delete files from the shared files folder. A second level of security is available if you enter a password in the Remote admin password box.



Open the QST pane at the bottom of the Chat tab and edit an existing QST or create a new one. You can now choose whether to send QSTs on the currently selected port or all ports.
